### What will I do as a Pharmacy Technician?

The main responsibilities of a Pharmacy Technician involve getting the right medication to the right patient, and teaching them to use it properly.

You'll take prescriptions, transcribe orders, calculate doses, work with drug distribution systems, prepare, pack, and label medications, and ensure that patients understand what they've been given and how to use it.
